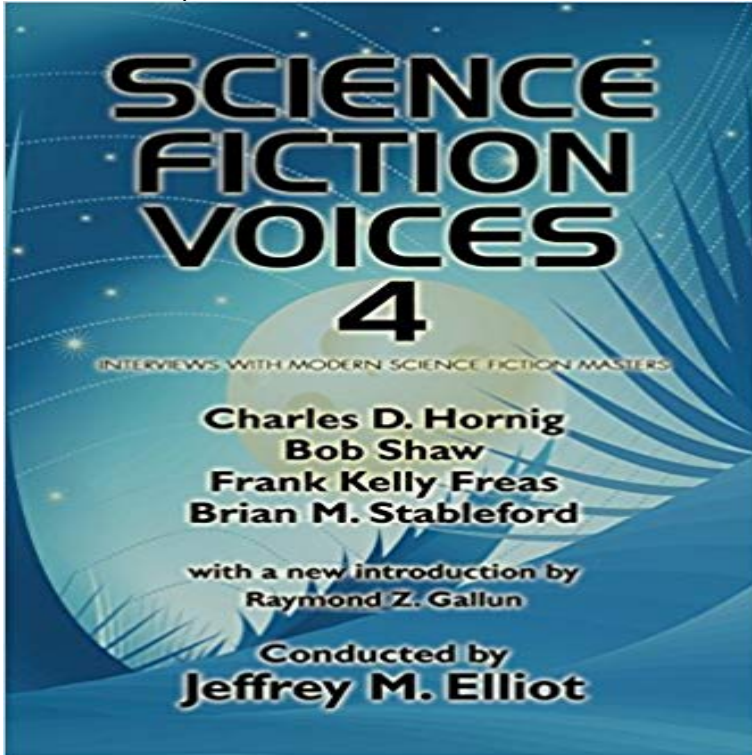


Science Fiction Voices #4: Interviews with Modern Science Fiction Masters (Science Fiction Voices No. 4)
