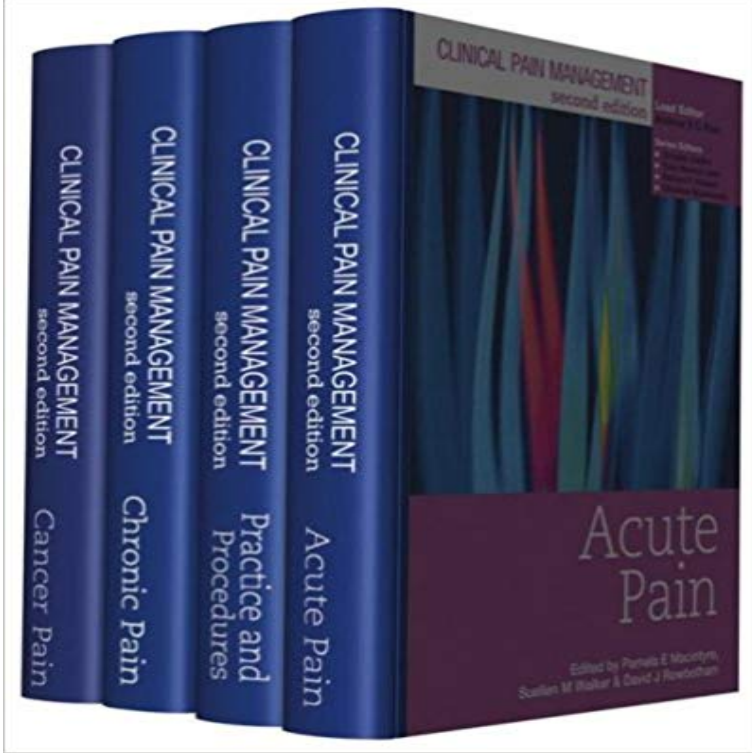


Clinical Pain Management: 4 volume set
