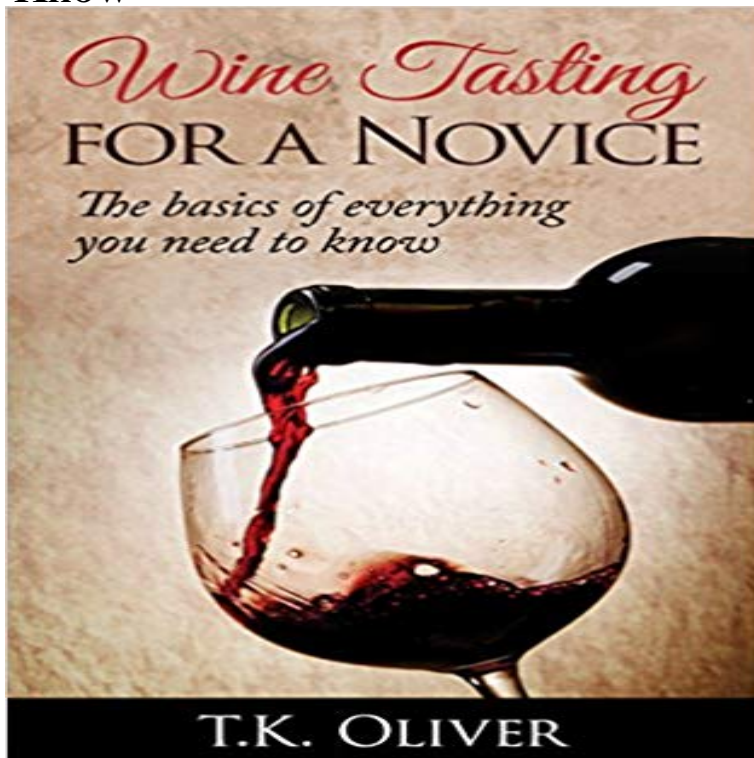


Wine Tasting for the Novice: The Basics of Everything You Need to Know
