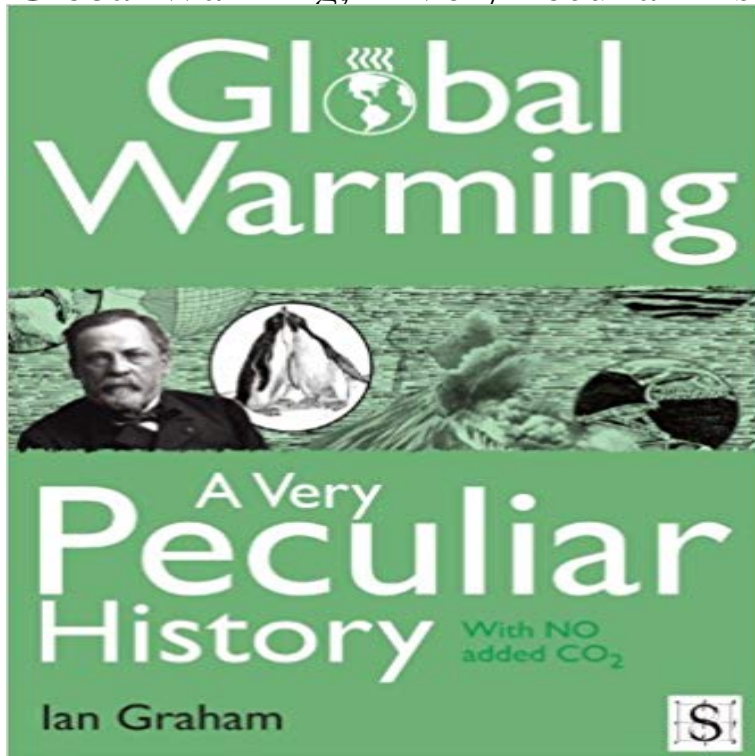


Global Warming, A Very Peculiar History
