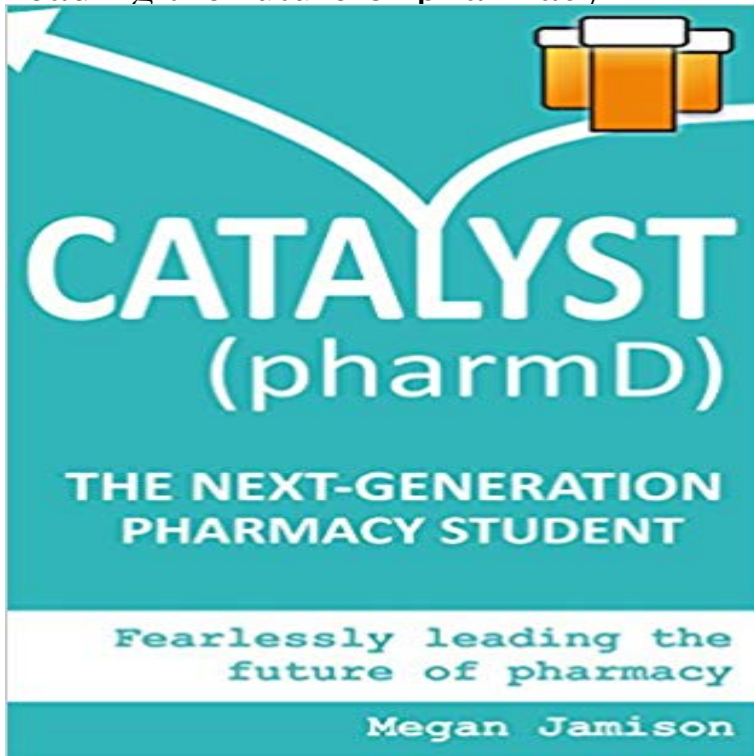


Catalyst (pharmD): The Next-Generation Pharmacy Student: Fearlessly leading the future of pharmacy
