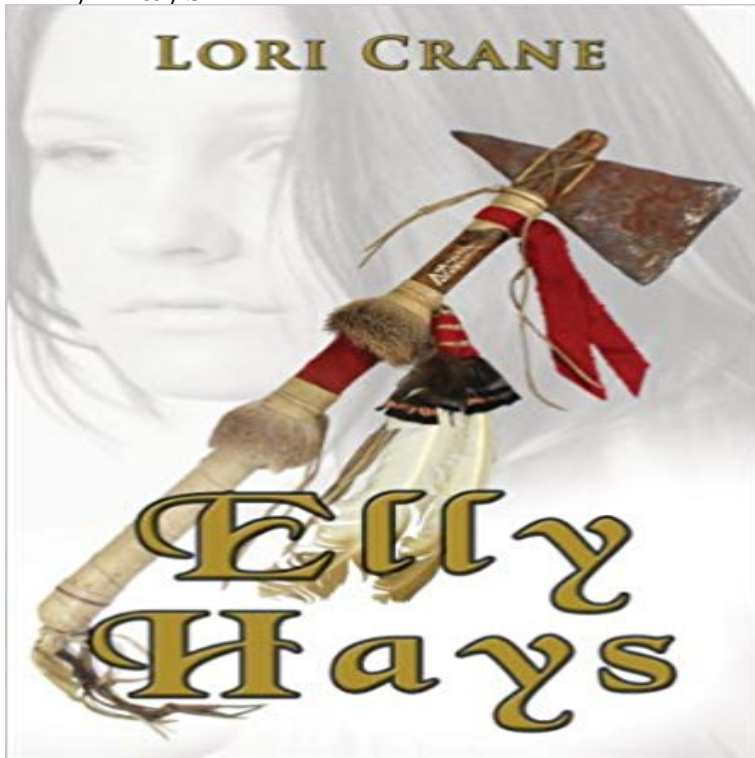


# Elly Hays
