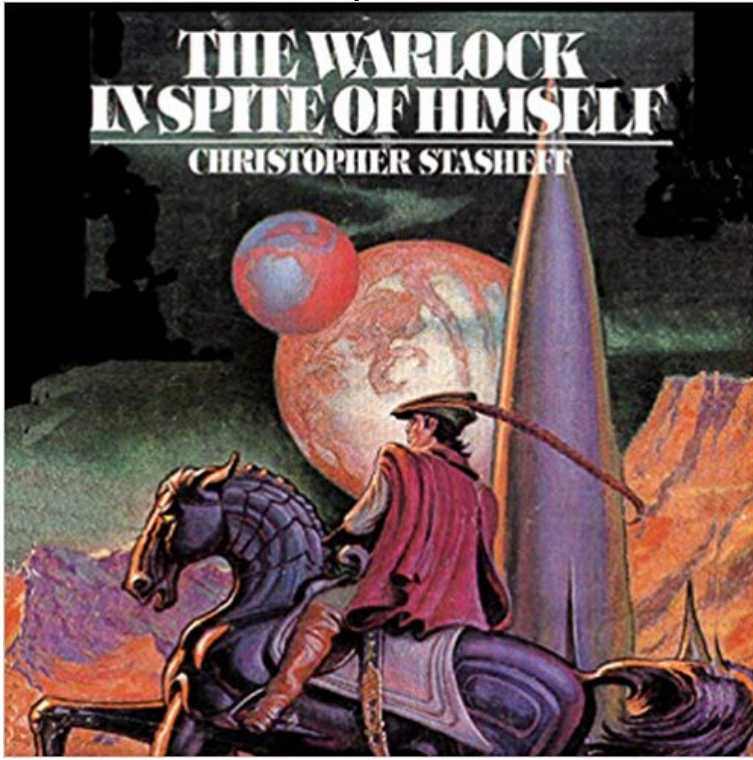


# The Warlock in Spite of Himself
