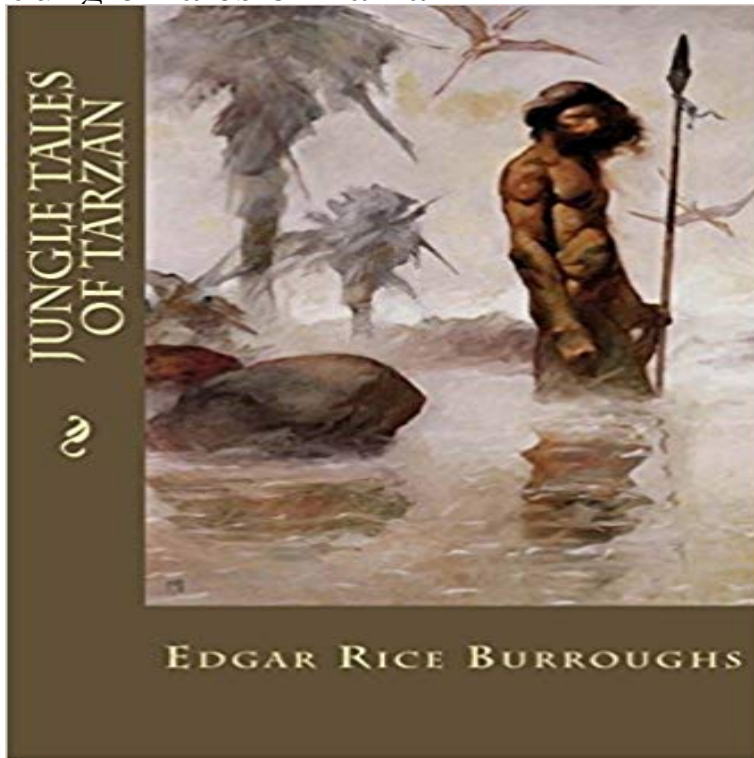


## Jungle Tales of Tarzan
