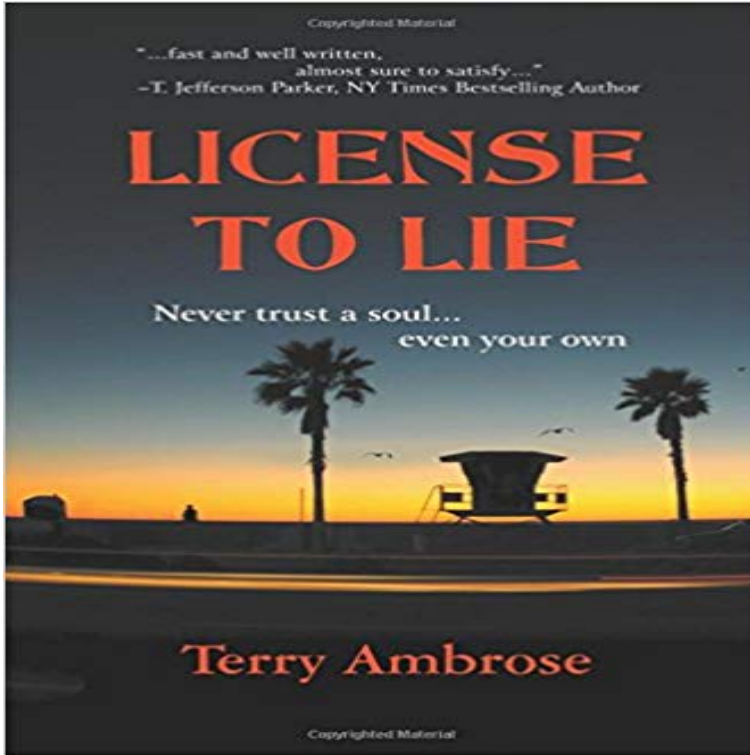


# License to Lie
