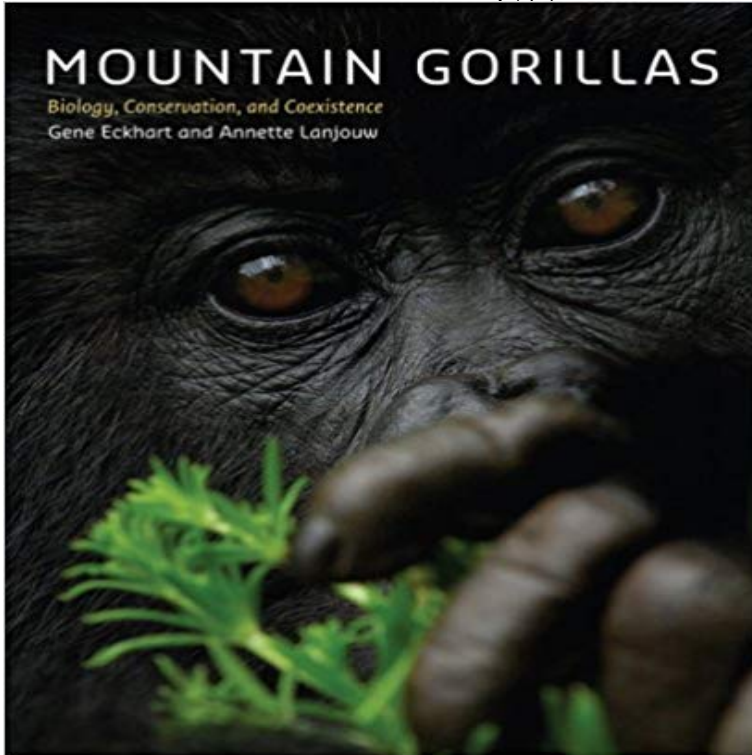


Mountain Gorillas: Biology, Conservation, and Coexistence
