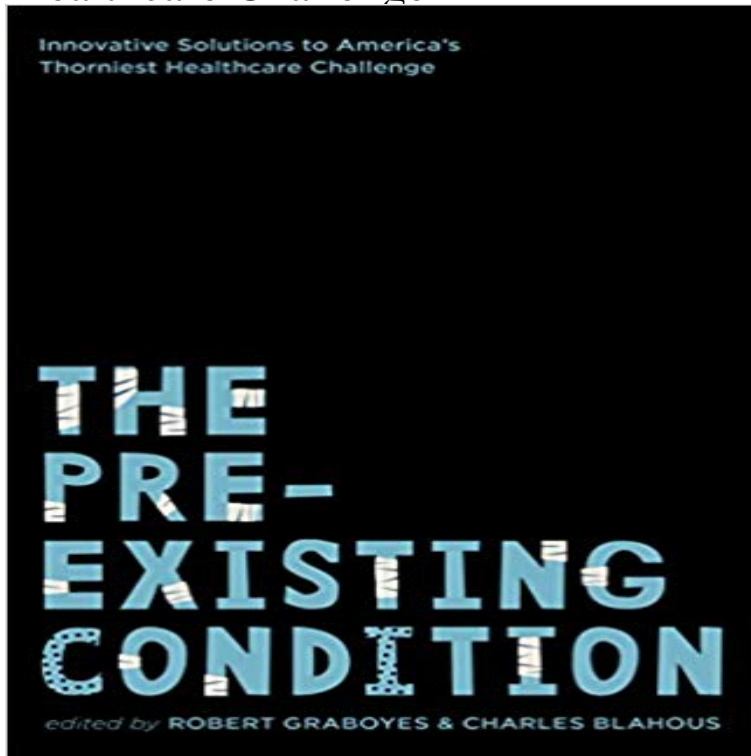


The Pre-existing Condition: Innovative Solutions to America's Thorniest Healthcare Challenge
