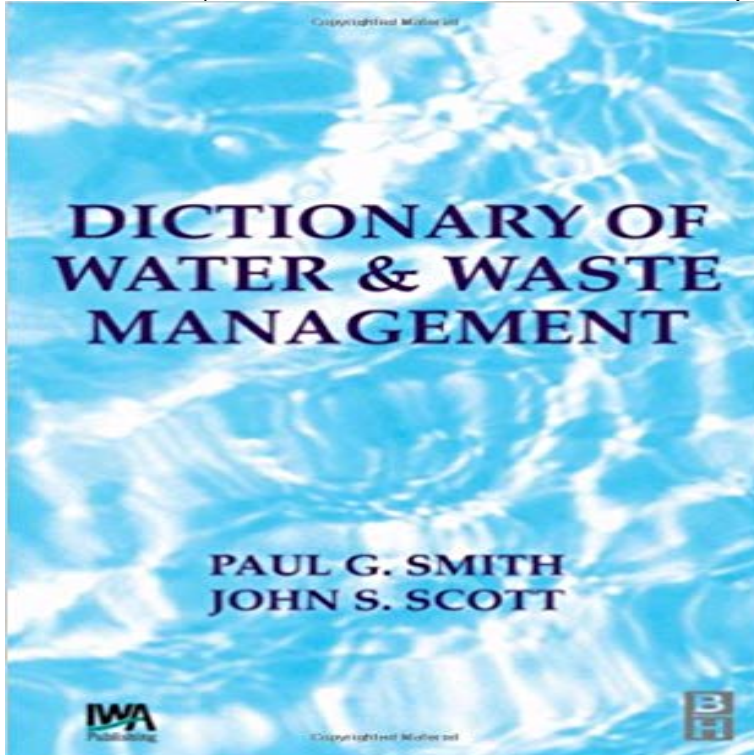


Dictionary of Water and Waste Management (Soul City)
